## Assessment

### Classroom Observations:

A significant part of the PGCE assessment involves observing students teach in a real classroom setting. This is often done by a mentor or a university tutor who evaluates the student's teaching effectiveness, classroom management, lesson planning, and ability to engage students.

### Teaching Practice Portfolio:

Students compile a portfolio that includes lesson plans, student feedback, teaching materials, and reflective commentary on their teaching practice.

### Microteaching Sessions:

These are short teaching sessions where students teach a small group of peers or learners. It allows them to practice and receive feedback on their teaching skills in a controlled environment.

### Peer Assessment:

Students might assess each other's teaching practices, providing feedback and suggestions for improvement.

### Essays:

Students may be asked to write essays of 1000 words after completing each unit on educational theories, pedagogical practices, or critical reflections on their teaching experiences. To be attached with a lesson plan and Scheme of work.
